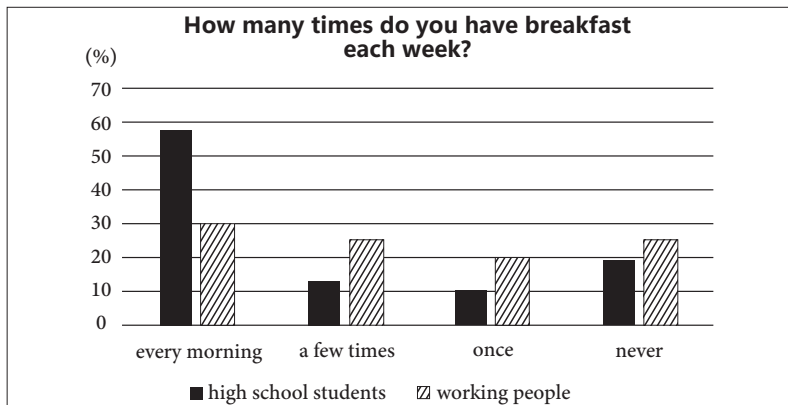

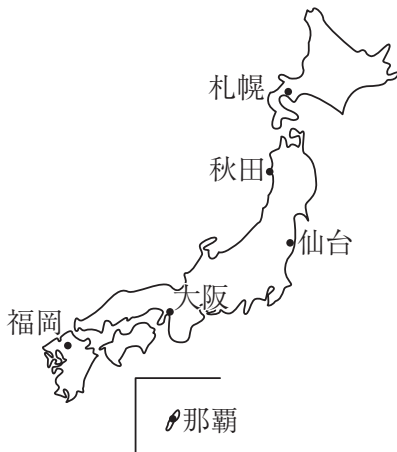
 Fares for people who are twelve years old and over are 420 yen, but fares for people over seventy are free.

This story is about an ice hockey team from a country in the *desert. They won an international tournament. The hockey team is from *the UAE. It is a true story.

Ice hockey is a sport that needs good skaters. Each team has five players and a goalkeeper. They have to skate very quickly to go around the other players and score a goal. Even when they change players, the game doesn't stop. So the players have to skate very quickly to and from the bench. This is why good skaters are important.

The UAE is a desert country. ② It's too hot to play sports outside, so the country has many indoor swimming pools, soccer fields and even ice skating rinks. Families often figure skate at shopping centers. When the UAE decided to make a national ice hockey team, the coach had ③ a good idea. He went to a figure skating club and asked the best skaters to join his team. It was easy to teach figure skaters to play hockey. Four months after they created the team, they went to their first international tournament in Hong Kong.

The tournament director, Tom Barnes, was surprised when a team from the desert came to the tournament. "I didn't think they would have good skaters. But when I first saw them, I was really surprised. Some of them could skate very well."

The tournament was at a skating rink in a shopping center. Men wearing traditional *robes walked into the shopping center with big hockey bags. So everyone noticed them. A lot of people went to the games to see whether the team could play hockey well or not. People found out that the UAE team was fast and exciting. So the desert team quickly became very popular.

Most teams had a few star players. The desert team didn't have any star players. But they had many very good (④). All of them worked very hard as a team, and they won many games. Finally they got to the championship game. The men from the desert won the game and became the tournament champions. The team skated around the ice with the trophy and their flag.

At the start of the tournament, people saw the hockey players carrying their bags in their desert robes and thought they would not be very good players. But those people were *wrong. This team taught all of us ⑤ a good lesson — "Don't judge a book by its cover."
